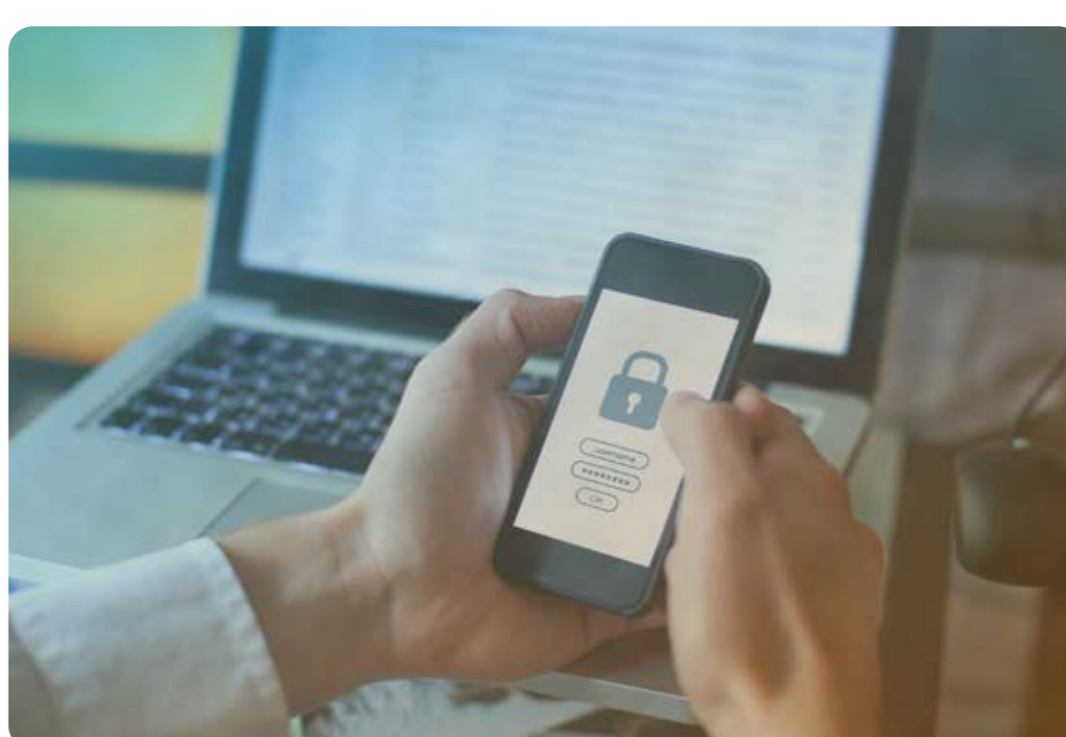
What is DMARC?

Domain-based Message Authentication, Reporting, and Conformance

DMARC is an email authentication system that protects your organization's domains from spoofing, phishing, and performing other cyber attacks. It builds on the widely deployed email verification techniques:

- SPF (Sender Policy Framework)
- DKIM (Domain Keys Identified Mail)

DMARC can make your email safe again

Criminals can easily take over your organization's brand. Without DMARC, emails that appear to originate from your domain can be used to steal personally identifiable information. Below are some examples:

Login Credential Theft

Pretending to be a customer support representative from your organization, the attacker can steal information from your customers and partners.

Fake Invoices

Impersonating a vendor, the hacker could send fake invoices that cost companies millions of dollars.

CEO Fraud

Claiming to be a top-level executive from your organization, the attacker could send an email to your employees, requesting access to confidential databases or even requesting money transfers.

Ransomware

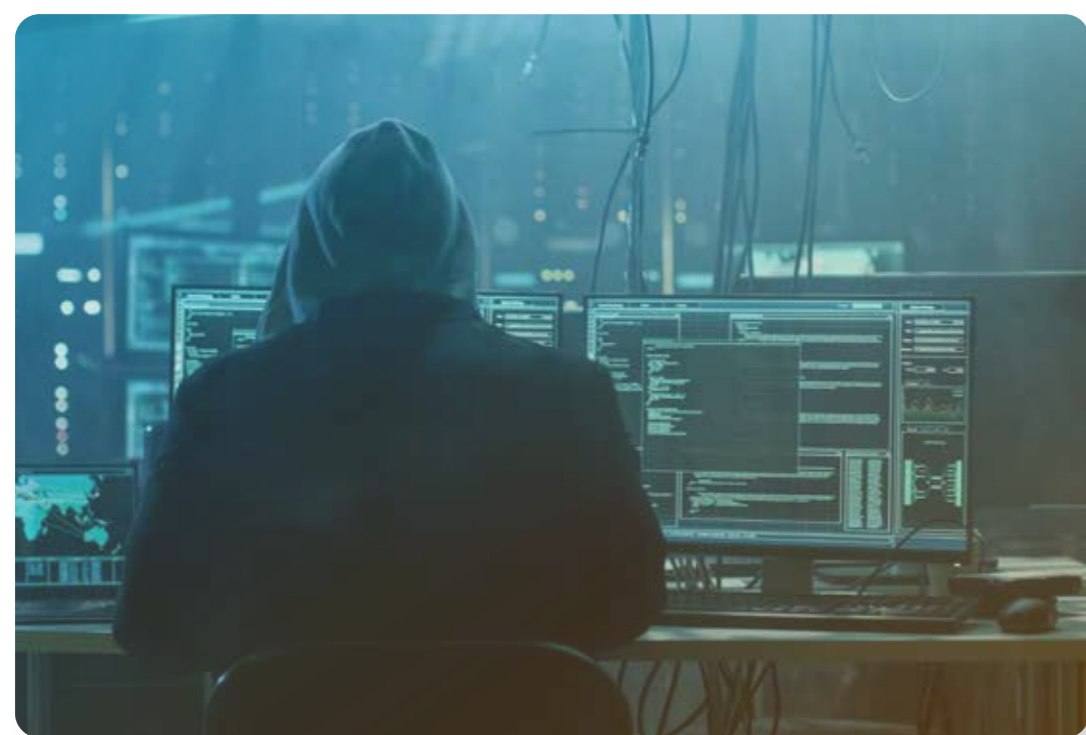
With a malicious email that contains fake links or attachments, the attacker can easily install ransomware on the target's device.

Illegal Goods

Armed with your domain, the attacker can use it to sell illegal goods online, such as drugs or weapons, which could land you into serious trouble.

Legal Risks

With your domain, the attacker can steal money or data from others, which can lead to lawsuits against your organization.
